**Geronimo Energy Awarded
NYSERDA Renewable Energy Credit Contract
for Ulster County, New York Solar Project**

Geronimo Energy, LLC (“Geronimo”) is pleased to announce that as a result of the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority’s (“NYSERDA”) 2017 solicitation, Geronimo’s Blue Stone Solar Project (“Blue Stone”), a solar energy project located in Zone G in Ulster County, New York, was awarded a long-term Renewable Energy Certificate (“REC”) contract.

Blue Stone is an estimated 19.99 megawatt (“MW”) solar facility near the town of Saugerties that offers an approximate timeline for construction and operations during 2019.

Blue Stone is a part of Geronimo’s growing New York project portfolio, which currently represents hundreds of megawatts of clean, renewable energy. “Geronimo looks forward to continuing to work with NYSEDA, as well as the multiple energy agencies, generators and wholesalers within the NYISO market,” said Geronimo Energy President, David Reamer. “This REC contract affords Geronimo the ability to continue its mission to deliver clean, renewable energy while boosting rural community economies, such as those in the New York state area.”

Announced in March, Blue Stone is one of 26 statewide large-scale renewable energy projects selected through NYSEDA’s first Large-Scale Renewable Solicitation, which resulted in the single largest commitment to renewable energy by a state in U.S. history at \$1.4 billion. Awards for NYSEDA’s second Large-Scale Renewable Solicitation are expected to be announced this fall.
